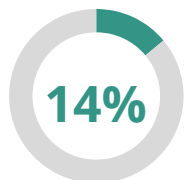

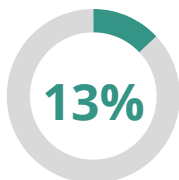

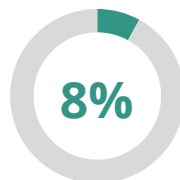
Intended Occupation, Employment Status, & Education Level at Registration



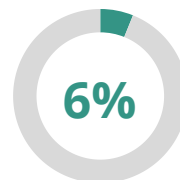

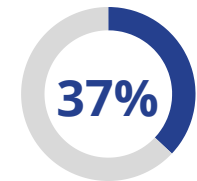

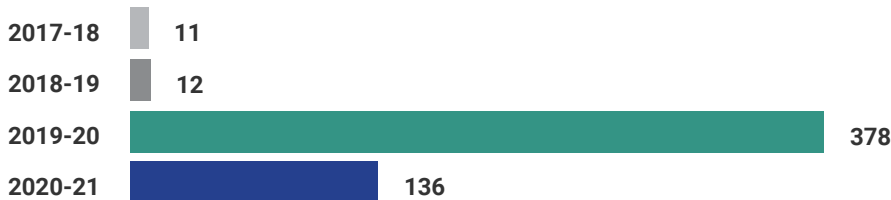

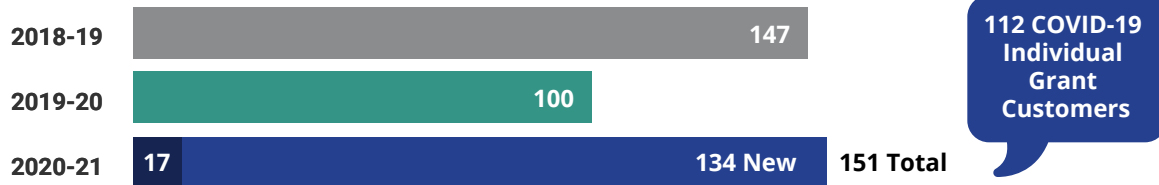

Number of Individuals Enrolled



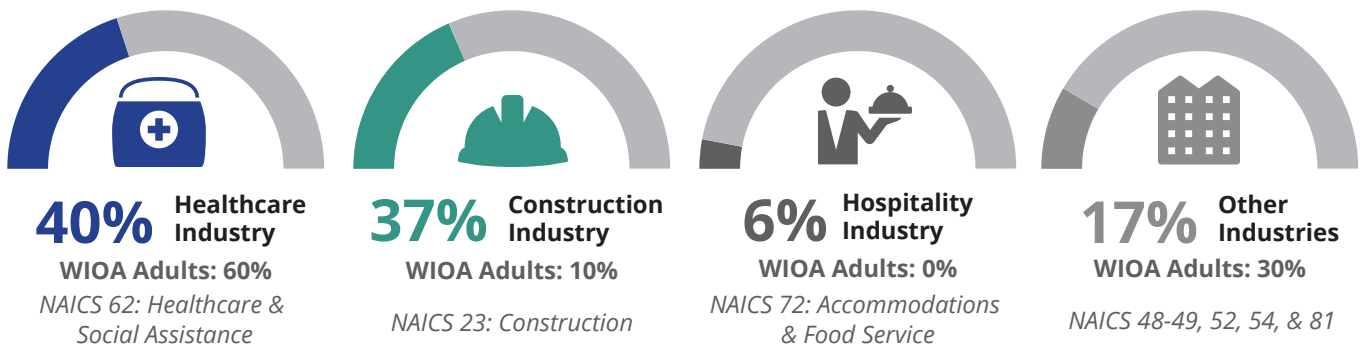
### WIOA Dislocated Worker Customers

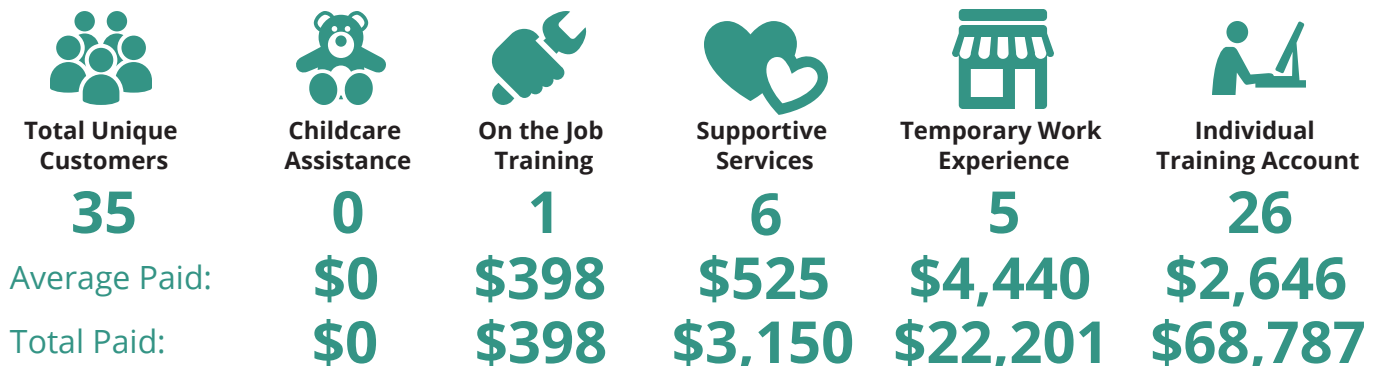


## Training & Supportive Services (WIOA & Prison to Employment)

### Hourly Living Wage Rate

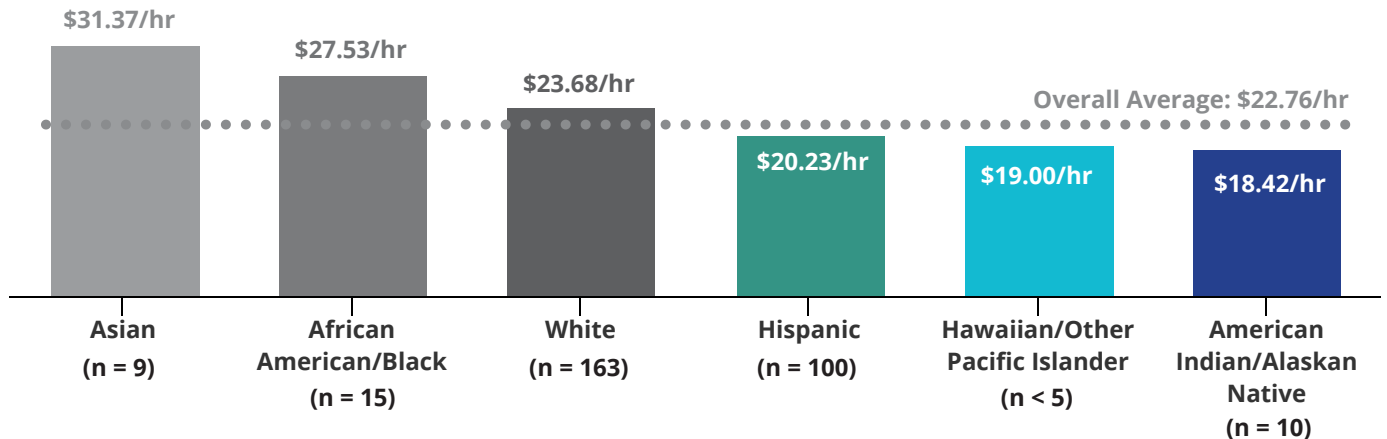
Adults Working Full Time in Sonoma County\*

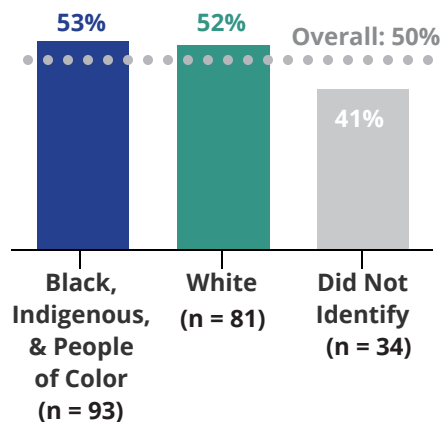
### Average Wage at Program Exit

Hourly Wages of Customers Who Reported a Job at Exit



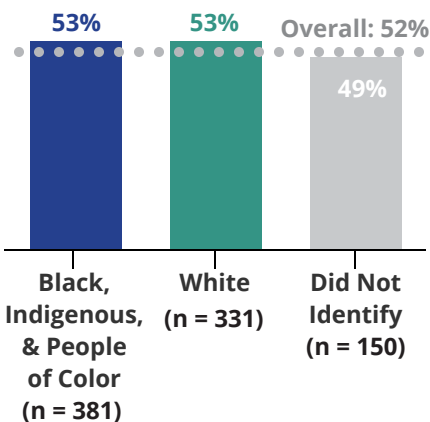
### Credential Attainment

Within a Year of Program Exit



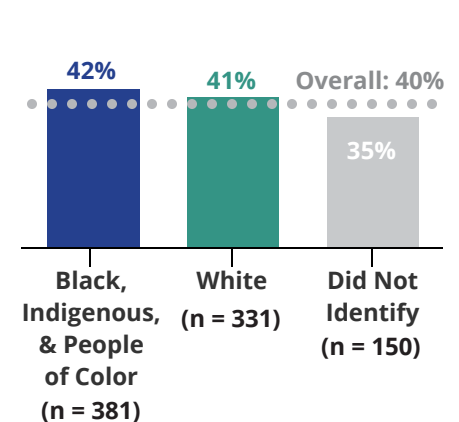

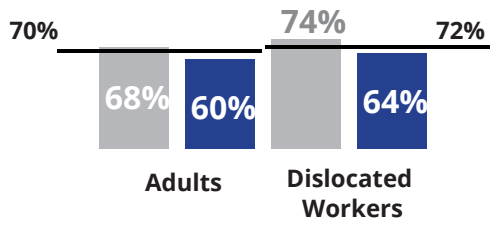

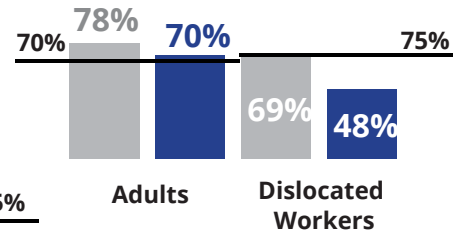

### Employment Rate (2nd Quarter)



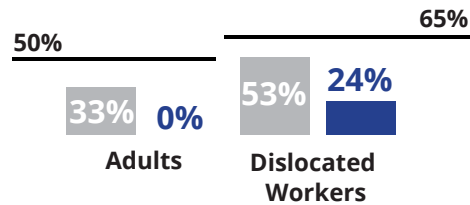
WIOA Adults & Dislocated Workers Employed During the 2nd Quarter After Exit

### Employment Rate (4th Quarter)



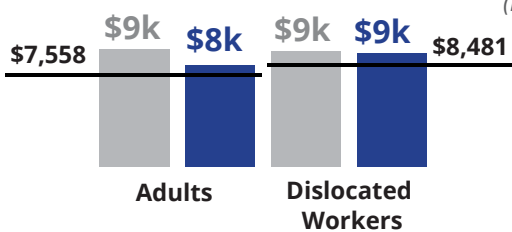
WIOA Adults & Dislocated Workers Employed During the 4th Quarter After Exit

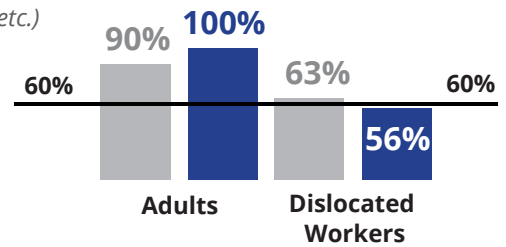

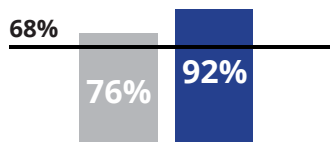


WIOA Adults & Dislocated Workers Who Attain a Credential Within a Year of Exit

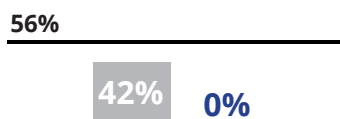

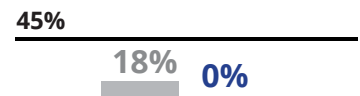
WIOA Youth Employed or Enrolled in Education or Training During the 2nd Quarter After Exit
