



Intended Occupation, Employment Status, & Education Level at Registration




WIOA Levels of Service

Levels of Service Accessed in Q1-Q3 of the 2021-2022 Program Year









WIOA Outcomes by Race & Ethnicity (2016-2022)





Median Quarterly Earnings




Median Quarterly Earnings for WIOA Adults & Dislocated Workers 2nd Quarter After Exit

Credential Attainment




WIOA Adults & Dislocated Workers Who Attain a Credential Within a Year of Exit
