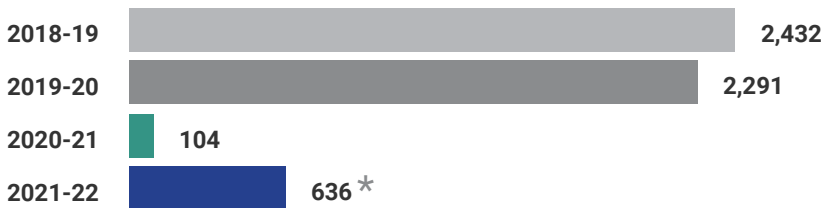

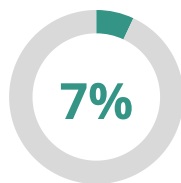

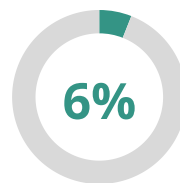

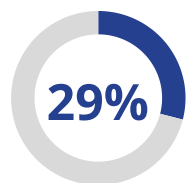

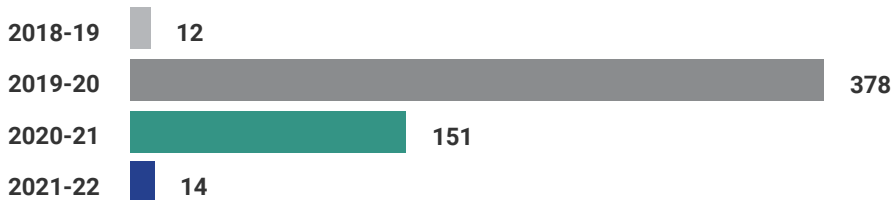

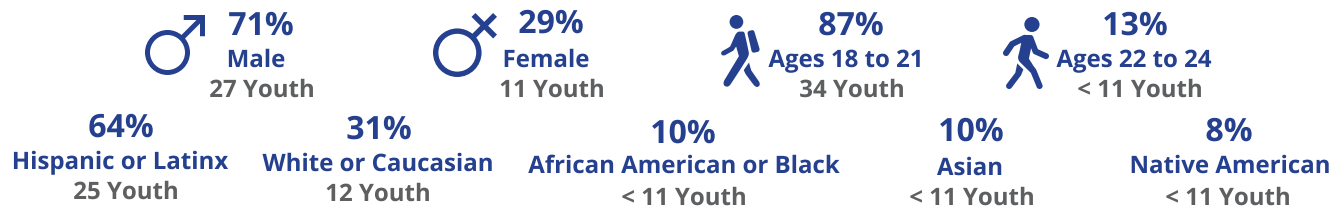

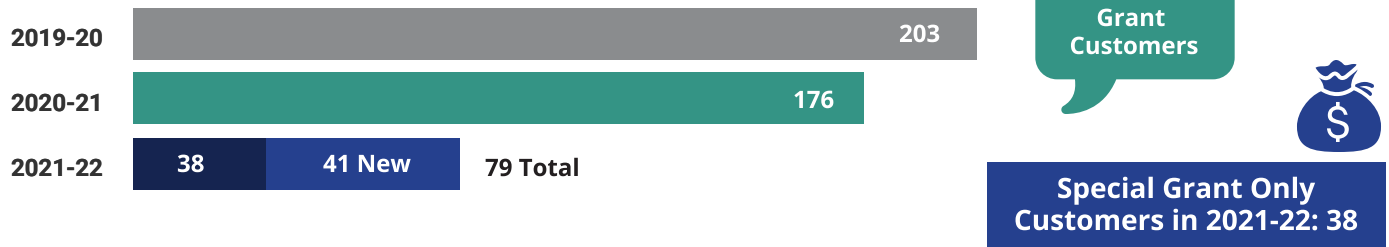

Number of Individuals Enrolled



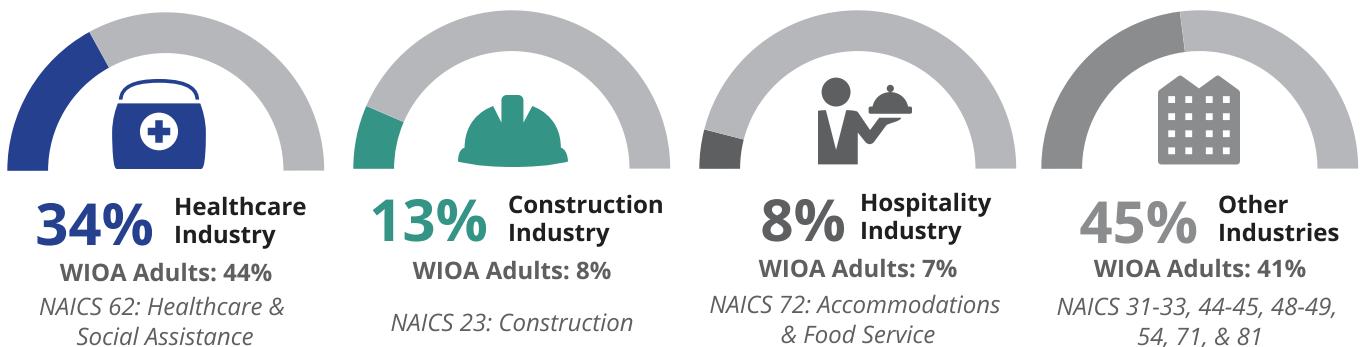

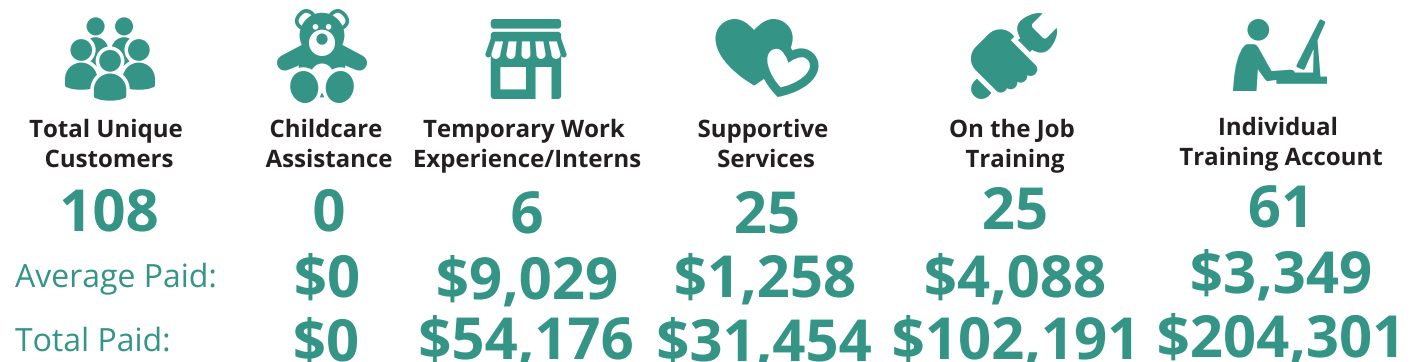


## Training & Supportive Services (WIOA & Prison to Employment)

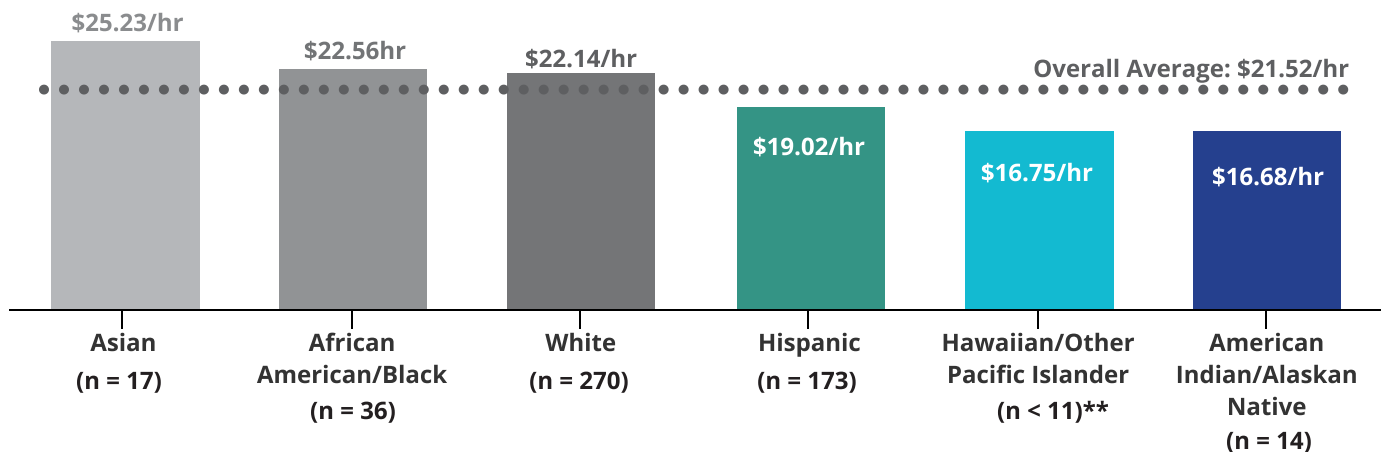

## WIOA Outcomes by Race & Ethnicity (2016-2022)

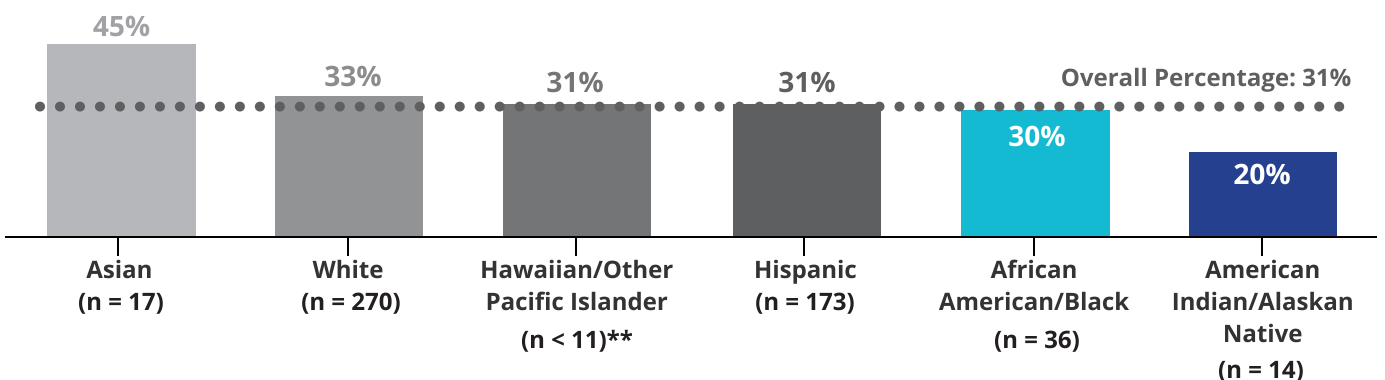
### Average Wage at Program Exit
